



2019 - 2020 Season

Points System

1. Points awarded at a tournament

Here are the rules applied in the points system this year:

- We do not give points for extra games (**A16, C11 and D01**). To avoid these games, the team will have to get a good **draw to the button** at the beginning of the tournament.
- For **game B01**, it follows the rules set out in the **tournament draft** and no additional points are awarded for the winner of that game.
- It should be remembered here that during the Qualifying Rounds, section A leads to section B and that section C leads to section D.
- The following points will be awarded to the **20 teams participating** in each of the 4 sections at the end of the tournament:

- Points (**PTB**) are awarded during **draw to the button** process.
- The team with the best performance will get **6.0 PTB points** while the twentieth team will get **0.3 PTB points**, therefore there will be an upgrade of **0.3 points** per rank. These points will be added to the team card at the end of the tournament to enhance the process and they will break the ties in the general standings.



2. General ranking for the DMMC league

- Each team cumulates points by participating in a **DMMC** league tournament.
- The teams general ranking is based on the amount of points accumulated during the season.
- The **DMMC** general standings serve to determine **seeding** before each tournament and also to establish the teams rank for the next tournament.

3. Participation in the tournament of Champions

- The **DMMC** general standings serve to determine the teams that will participate in the **tournament of Champions**.
- In case of a tie in the general standings, the following rules will apply to finalise the teams ranking:
 1. The most points won in the **A** section, otherwise...
 2. The most points won in the **B** section, otherwise...
 3. The most points won in the **C** section, otherwise...
 4. The most points won in the **D** section, otherwise...
 5. Previous standing.
- At the end of the season, the **first 4 teams** in the general standings will qualify for the **Tournament of Champions**.
